## Special Job Training Course Available at Honesdale High School

### Intermediate Shielded Metal Arc Welding - 8 Week/90 Hours

This course provides the necessary knowledge and skills for an entry-level welder. Oxy-fuel, gas tungsten arc (TIG), Gas Metal Arc (MIG), and Shielded Metal Arc (Stick) processes are taught with theory and hands-on practice. Students will attend lectures about basic metallurgy, welding codes, non-destructive examination, and welding symbols and learn advanced skills in the Shielded Metal Arc process (Stick). Emphasis is placed on the student's ability to prepare material and perform welding of fillet and groove welds in carbon steel using E7018 electrodes in all positions. Practice is geared toward Structural Welding Code vertical and overhead tests. Students will have the opportunity to take the qualification test.
