1. Describe the host's educational oversight to ensure students with disabilities are educated in the least restrictive environment while in the 1306 facility? (If not a host, answer as if you were.)

Within the Western Wayne School District's boundaries are two 1306 facilities. The first facility provides court-appointed group home support for school-age students, and the other provides in-patient treatment services for adults (18 years old and up). As the host district, WWSD takes numerous steps to ensure students with disabilities within these facilities are placed in the least restrictive environment. When WWSD is alerted of new students entering either of the facility locations, a request for records is made by the district to determine if the student entering is a student identified under Chapter 14 of the IDEA or Chapter 15 of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. The district's Instructional Services Office is notified for students already identified under either of these provisions, and IEP/504 records are sent for review. If the student is being placed by the court and has been moved from their "home" district, the Best Interest Determination (BID) is conducted with all applicable team members, always including the Director or Assistant Director of Special Education, to determine if the host district is in the best interest of the student. At this time, additional information is shared, and the team discusses student programming. The district will consider all provided documentation to determine educational placement to ensure that the student has the least restrictive environment and that FAPE is offered. The district will always consider educational placement options within the district before seeking an out-of-district placement. An out-of-district placement will be considered only when the IEP team discusses the student's identified needs and the availability of programming within the district cannot meet those needs. Per the district's Child Find obligations, students thought to be eligible for special education services and accommodations within the district's jurisdiction have a responsibility to locate, identify, and evaluate all 1306 students with suspected disabilities, including but not limited to evaluating students for whom a request for an evaluation has been made. If, through the intake

process or upon starting, the student is suspected of eligibility under either Chapter 14 of the IDEA or Chapter 15 of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, appropriate steps will be taken to obtain consent to initiate the evaluation process. Based on Act 1 of 2022, students who experience educational instability may require additional support such as Evaluations, re-evaluations, or assistance with graduation plans; thus, measures will be taken to ensure that supports are in place and, if applicable, IEPs align with graduation plans.

2. Describe the district's procedures for communicating with 1306 facilities and how the district ensures a successful transition back to school?

Consistent and open communication is maintained with the host district, the 1306 facility, and guardians (natural or count appointed) while the student is enrolled. Per the IEP, progress is monitored and reported, at minimum, quarterly, with more frequent progress communicated as needed per the student's mastery or if concerns arise. If during the time the student is enrolled, the student is placed back in their home district and reunified with their family, the district makes themselves available to participate in additional BIDs to ensure the current progress and documentation are shared to ensure a smooth transition back to their home district can occur. Suppose the student is a student who, upon enrollment, was placed in an out-of-district setting. In that case, the district remains the LEA and participates in all annual meetings or reconvene meetings that take place concerning the student. In the event, it is recommended that the student return to the host district's buildings, the district supports the transition back to the typical setting and programs based on the student's needs. When a resident student is placed outside of the Western Wayne School District "home district" into a 1306 facility outside of district boundaries, contact will be made with the facility to request participation in treatment meetings and discharge planning meetings. The district would participate in and help prepare for the student's return when made aware of these meetings. The district would consider revisions to the current IEP or 504. Additional programming or services would be considered.

Least Restrictive Environment

- 1. Review the district's data for Least Restrictive Environment. Highlight areas of improvement.
 - Per 34 CFR § 30.114(a)(b) the Western Wayne School District strives to ensure students with disabilities are educated with children who are nondisabled to the maximum extent appropriate for the student and that special classes, separate school, or other removals from the regular education environment occurs if the nature or severity of the disability is such that the use of supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily by the student. During the 2022-2023 school year, based on the SEDR report, the following information was gathered regarding the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE): 62.0% of identified students were placed in the regular education setting for 80% or more of their day. This is a change from the 2021-2022 report. The LEA has increased the number of students in the regular education setting. Additionally, the LEA number of 62.0% is slightly above the State number of 61.6% 9.9% of the students were placed in the regular education setting for less than 40% of their day. This is a change from the 2021-2022 report. The LEA has decreased the number from 11.4% to 9.9%, which is also slightly below the State number of 10.0%. 3.8% of the LEA population is reported in Other Settings. This is a slight change from the 2021-2022 school year report of 3.3%. This variation is also below the State number of 4.4%. Based on the 2022-2023 school year report, the LEA has been identified as being below the State averages. However, the LEA continues to improve its practices and programming supports to ensure students are provided with a continuum of services, a supportive curriculum, and supplemental instruction to ensure students participate in the most meaningful way.
- 2. What universal practices does the district utilize to address the academic and social/emotional needs of all students in need of accommodations to their learning environments?
 - Students with disabilities are identified for academic or behavioral services through a Multi-Tiered System of Support. The LEA has building-level teams (Student Concerns, Student Assistance Program, and Chil-Study) frequently meeting to address individual students' needs. Each team collects pertinent information to address needs, concerns, and strengths. Students identified at the SAP/Student Concern level and requiring additional monitoring are referred to Child Study. During Child Study, students are discussed, and, as a multi-disciplinary team, recommendations are made for additional support or if the student should be considered as an identified student under Chapter 14 of IDEA or Chapter 15 of Section 504.
- 3. Describe the academic programming and training efforts the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in the general education curriculum.
 - The LEA provides a continuum of services focusing on the Least Restrictive Environment for students identified. Faculty and staff receive professional development to help support students within the general education setting or special education setting. Faculty and Staff receive training, programming strategies, and instructional practices to ensure students make meaningful progress in their least

restrictive environment. The LEA fosters professional growth by providing identified workshops, websites, and professional development that deal with classroom needs, student needs, and staff needs. The LEA is also supportive of self-identified professional development as teachers and staff build their knowledge for special education supports and services. To support students with disabilities in the general education setting and within the general education curriculum, the following are supplementary aids and services that may be included based on identified needs: • modified/functional curricular goals • providing alternate ways for students to demonstrate learning • providing test modifications • providing alternate materials (e.g., materials on tape, large print, computer access) • providing assistive technology • changing method of presentation • providing instruction on functional skills • specific seating arrangements • identified adaptive equipment • adjustments to sensory input (e.g., light, sound) • counseling/ social work support • Individualized behavior support plans

4. Describe the supplementary aids and services the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in extracurricular activities.

All students are welcome and encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities offered by the district. The LEA makes every effort to support that student in their extracurricular interests. While students who are identified as students with disabilities are still required to meet extracurricular eligibility criteria, assisting them academically and behaviorally is done through their IEP supports and services. Additionally, the LEA participates in Unified sports (Special Olympics) to ensure students with disabilities have access to extracurricular activities with their general education peers.

5. Describe the District procedures, which ensure that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities placed in private institutions are educated with non-disabled children and have the opportunity to participate in district lead extracurricular activities?

Students with disabilities residing in the District can participate in LEA-led extracurricular activities. Procedures include sharing information on the District website, social media and during public meetings. For students in alternative settings, the LEA maintains open communication, regularly attends IEP/reconvene meetings, and monitors progress to determine if or when a student is ready to return to a less restrictive placement.

6. Discuss the district's need to build capacity and expand programs and services in an effort to provide a continuum of services. (Consider the out of district placement chart)

The 2022-2023 report noted that special education students in Other Settings made up 3.8% of the identified population. The LEA's 3.8% is lower than the State average of 4.4%. Currently, the LEA continues programming for students in grades K through 12. Programming includes regular education classes, co-teacher classes, itinerant learning support classes, supplemental learning support classes,

replacement learning support classes, autistic support, and emotional support. When a student is identified to need a more restrictive environment, the LEA will seek out established placements that focus on meeting the student's programming needs.

1. How does the district support the emotional, social needs of students with disabilities?

- 1. The district supports students' emotional and social needs through a three-tier approach. The first universal tier includes the implementation of PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) in an effort to encourage and reinforce prosocial behavior for all students, including those with disabilities. Additionally, as a tier-one approach, the district provides all students with access to nine school counselors and four school nurses. The second tier of social and emotional support for students with disabilities is provided through the consultation and access of six BCBAs (Board Certified Behavior Analysts), as well as two social workers, with anticipation of a third, who work with students in grades kindergarten through age 21+ on skills to address social and emotional needs; working on building student engagement, peer relationships, positive teacher relationships, and healthy family and community interactions. For students with more intensive social, emotional, and behavioral needs, the district has created tier three support by employing two LPCs (licensed practicing counselors) for students who have been identified and require emotional support programming. The school-based counselors their students' regular and special education teachers' classrooms, collect observational behavioral data, assist with creating and instructing behavior plans, and meet with students for individual services.
- 2. Describe training provided to staff in the use of positive behavior supports, de-escalation techniques and responses to behavior that may require immediate intervention.
 - Upon initiation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), all district staff were trained on the purpose and implementation procedures. Since PBIS has been implemented, each school year periodic booster trainings are held to refresh the staff on PBIS procedures and orient staff to new components being added to the PBIS program. Staff are an active part in the development of PBIS procedures and components. The Western Wayne School District has implemented Therapeutic Aggression Control Techniques (TACT2) as the model for de-escalation. A significant percentage of staff are fully trained in TACT2 techniques, including restraints. All district staff are provided with a 1 hour training each school year on TACT2 de-escalation techniques including how to respond to a

student who is escalated or approaching a crisis. This 1 hour training includes procedures to follow if a student requires immediate intervention, such as moving other students to a safe location, calling the internal crisis assistance number and strategies for remaining calm. Furthermore, all staff involved in a situation that required de-escalation techniques or immediate intervention participate in a debriefing session with the TACT2 trainers of the district (Special Education Director and Supervisor of Pupil Personnel). This allows a structured approach to processing escalated/crisis situations, problem-solving, and discussing alternatives (if any) to the incident.

3. Describe the district positive school wide support programs.

3. As mentioned, the district utilizes PBIS in all buildings. The district adopted the acronym PRIDE: Students exhibit that they are prepared, Respectful, have integrity, are dedicated, and are extraordinary. Embedded within PBIS, each building circulates and promotes the use of "Cat Cash," a reward system for the promotion of positive behaviors throughout the school day/setting. Cat Cash is then used for social events and approved items within the school store. Each building houses its own school store with items purposefully designed to attract its student population's interest and buy-in. In addition to the Cat Cash and school store, buildings hold periodic "blow-outs" for students who have maintained positive behaviors throughout an identified period of time. PBIS is not just for students. Staff, too, are provided with incentives for participation to encourage PBIS success. Periodic rewards and acknowledgement are created to show staff appreciation for their efforts in supporting positive student growth.

4. Describe the district school-based behavior health services.

In addition to the above-mentioned, school-based health services also include partnerships with community-based mental health agencies to provide school-based mental health services within the school setting as an effort to expose and promote mental health services in a way that can be obtainable to all students.

5. Describe the district restraint procedure.

The Western Wayne School District has implemented Therapeutic Aggression Control Techniques (TACT2) training with a significant percentage of staff. Should a situation arise with a student that may result in a restraint, a staff trained in TACT2 is notified and responds. Verbal de-escalation strategies are attempted and if the student becomes a danger to themselves or someone else and the student cannot be maintained safely, a TACT2 restraint is utilized by a trained individual. Once the restraint is concluded, the student is examined by the school nurse and a parent/guardian is notified if not done so while the incident is occurring. The parent/guardian is offered an IEP reconvene meeting to be held ASAP (ideally the next day the student returns to school) to review the incident and determine if any revisions to the student's IEP are required or if additional assessments are appropriate to identify needs. Additionally, a Restraint Reporting Form developed by the district is completed by the staff who initiated and completed the restraint. This form is signed by the staff and building administrator, then sent to the Instructional Services office for review, reporting, and filing. Lastly, a debriefing meeting is held with all staff involved in the restraint to review, problem solve and discuss alternatives (if any) to the incident.
