It is recommended that the Board of Education adopt the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year Tentative Budget showing estimated available resources of \$57,263,180.00 and

estimated expenditures and ending fund balance in the amount of \$57,263,180.00 establishing real estate tax millage of **17.3793** with a 2% discount if the whole amount of the tax is paid within two months after the date of the tax notice; payment at face if the tax is paid within five months after the date of the tax notice, December 31, 2020.
