Dear Parents/Guardians,

There have been multiple confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 throughout the District. EverGreen Elementary School has **one** confirmed positive with twenty close contacts. RDW has **two** confirmed positives with forty-one close contacts. The Middle School has **three** confirmed positives with eighty-seven close contacts. The High School has **two** confirmed positives with seven close contacts. The High School and Middle School campus have a total of **eight** confirmed positives, and RDW has **two** in the past 14 days.

Per the Department of Health's guidelines, the recommendation is to shift to a fully virtual educational setting for two to three days at the High School, Middle School and RDW. Beginning tomorrow, **Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday April 28<sup>th</sup>** students in these building will shift to a completely virtual educational mode. Unless otherwise recommended by the DOH, students may return to in person instruction on **Thursday April 29<sup>th</sup>**. EverGreen Elementary will continue with in person instruction until further notice. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and work with the DOH to determine if a change in instructional modes is necessary and appropriate. We appreciate your understanding and flexibility and please contact us with any questions.
