



## STUDENT/CUSTODY AGREEMENT

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Divorces and separations among the adult world are on the rise bringing new problems for schools. In such situations it becomes extremely important for school administrators to know the following:

1. With which parent does the child reside if there is no custody agreement or court order? \_\_\_\_\_
2. If there is a custody agreement, is a copy on file with the school?  Yes  No
3. If there is a court order granting custody rights, is a copy on file with the school?  Yes  No

Children living in homes as a result of custody arrangements determined by the court can present a problem for school administrators. In order not to be placed in the middle of such situations, we ask that each parent who has a child residing with him/her, in a circumstance such as listed above, to complete the following form. This will help provide the necessary precautions for the child, the parent, and the school, in the event an administrator must make any decisions relative to the child.

**JUST A REMINDER THAT IN A DIVORCE SITUATION, IF THERE IS NO COURT-ORDERED CUSTODY FOR A CHILD, BOTH PARENTS HAVE EQUAL ACCESS TO INFORMATION CONCERNING THE CHILD.**
