Please be advised that due to a water main leak, the Western Wayne Middle School and High School campus has shut off the water to the buildings at the conclusion of the school day today. Repairs began after dismissal and are expected to be completed over the weekend. However, in the event that the repairs cannot be completed on time, or the water system is not fully ready to accommodate school on Monday 10/24/22, the High School and Middle School may utilize a virtual/asynchronous Flexible Instructional Day (FID). RDW and EverGreen will continue with a regular school day on Monday as this situation does not impact those campuses.
