LATE BUSES WILL HAVE SIGNS IN THEIR FRONT WINDOWS FOR WHICH DIRECTION THEY'RE TRAVELING ("SOUTHBOUND" OR "NORTHBOUND"). STUDENTS ARE URGED TO DOUBLE CHECK WITH THE DRIVER WHICH DIRECTION THEY TRAVEL TO AND TO ALSO GIVE THEM THE SPOT THEY NEED TO BE DROPPED OFF, AS SOON AS THEY BOARD THE BUS.

The SOUTHBOUND late buses will travel the following routes: 4:30 PM Late Bus leaves the middle school at 4:15 pm and the high school at 4:30 pm (From Door 004, by the band room and room 405). The bus then goes south on Rt. 296 and will go anywhere necessary as stated in the 5:30 pm southbound routes.

5:30 PM Late Bus (east of Hamlin): The bus leaves the middle school at 5:15 pm and the high school at 5:30 pm (From Door 004, by the band room and room 405). The bus then heads south on Rt. 296 and takes the left toward Gravity Road. It gets to the top of the hill then takes a right toward Lake Ariel corners. It stops at St. Thomas Moore Church and then goes up Tresslarville Rd. The bus then takes a left on Rt. 296 toward Morgan Hill. The bus will pass the Evergreen School and can make a drop there in the back of the building if necessary. Once to Hamlin corners the bus can then make a drop at the Rite Aid if necessary. The bus then turns left on to 590, continues to the main entrance at the Hideout and can make stops on the way including Ritter's Farmstand and Quik Joe's. The bus then enters the Hideout and stops at the south Main Lodge (Tiki Bar) and continues to the North Recreation pool. The bus then exits the Hideout and turns onto Avoy and then right onto Miller Road toward Rt. 590 and turns left onto 590 towards Pranzo's Auto Body. Then turns right on to St. Mary's Road and continues to Ledgesdale with a stop at Indian Rocks. It continues north on Ledgesdale Road, turns left on to Rt 191 south. The final stop is at Interstate 84 Onvo.

5:30 PM Late Bus (west of Hamlin): The bus will leave the middle school at 5:15 pm and the high school at 5:30 pm (From Door 004, by the band room and room 405). The bus then heads south onto Rt 296 and turns left onto Tresslarville Road to Lake Ariel turning right onto 191 south with a stop at the Lake Ariel Onvo/Lake Ariel Fire Hall. The bus then continues 191 south toward Hamlin and turns right onto Sawmill Road. It then turns right onto 590 and bears right onto 348. The bus then turns right onto Maplewood Road to the Maplewood Fire Hall making stops along the way. The bus then turns left onto Lake Henry Road, following it to Rt. 348 then turns left on Rt. 348 back toward Hamlin then right onto Parry Road to 590/690, left onto Neville Road stops at the Neville trailer park continues onto Springhill Road past Olsommer Tree Farm and stops at Sterling Gardens Road and turns around. It then follows Spring Hill Road back to Sterling Corners, turns right onto Easton Turnpike toward the final stop at Pocono Springs main entrance.

The NORTHBOUND late buses will travel the following routes:

4:30 PM Late bus: This bus leaves the middle school at 4:15 pm and the high school at 4:30 pm (From Door 004, by the band room and room 405). The bus goes north on Rt. 296. The bus will go anywhere necessary as stated in the 5:30 pm northbound routes.

5:30 PM Late bus: Bus will leave R.D. Wilson at 5:00 pm to go to the middle school. This bus will leave the middle school at 5:15 pm and then leave from the high school at 5:30 pm (From Door 004, by the band room and room 405). This bus turns north on Rt 296, stops at Country Traits, then turns left onto Cortez Road, stops at Lake Quinn Road, stops at Schotts Road, and then to McKinnie Road where the bus will turn around. The bus will then return on Cortez, cross Rt 296 onto St. Tikhon's Road then turns left onto Tuttle Hill, if necessary, it will travel straight onto the Owego Turnpike and turn left and make any stops along the Owego toward Waymart. It turns right onto Rt 296 and makes stops in Waymart at RDW, Florence, Myrtle, South Street and Honesdale Road where it turns left and travels up Carbondale Road and turns around at Gravity Apartments. It returns to Rt 296 north, it crosses Rt 6, stop at gas stations if necessary, and continues north with a stop at South Smith Road. The bus then continues north on 296 and turns right onto Elk Lake Drive, then turns left onto Cross Road to White Oak Road, turns right and continues to Rt. 170, where it turns left onto Rt 170 (Creek Drive) north to the intersection with Rt 247 and turns around. It then heads south on Rt 170 (Creek Drive) to Rt. 6, turns right and then left on Keen Lake Road with a stop at O'Connell Road. It continues straight on Keen Lake Road and turns right onto Little Keen Road crossing Rt 6. The bus continues on Little Keen Road to Stanton Drive and takes a right following road to Elk Lake Drive where it then turns right onto Elk Lake Drive, continues Rt 6 and takes a left with the final stop at Cavage's Market.
