#### 16. E-rate Funding Application

The Board of Education approved the E-Rate Funding Application as follows:

a. Category 1 – This motion covers the fiber-optic connections to Evergreen and Robert D. Wilson Elementary schools with Adams Cable. This E-Rate submission allows payment for year two of a three year contract. If awarded, E-rate funding will cover approximately \$1,216.00 of the \$1,520.00 monthly payment, contingent on receiving the E-rate funding. The total of \$304.00 monthly will be owed by Western Wayne to Adams Cable.

#### 17. Agreement - Transfinder Software

The Board of Education approved an agreement with Transfinder Corporation of Schenectady, NY for the purchase and use of their transportation software at an initial cost of \$12,990 with a yearly maintenance fee after the first year of \$4,950.00. Also, allow the administration to explore their stop finder communication option and if needed, allow the additional cost of \$1,200.00 per year.
