These clearance reports are minimal in cost, approximately \$25.00, and they are good for five years. When applying on-line **Enter Service Code: 1KG6Y3 for Volunteers, which will qualify you to receive ACT 34 and ACT 151 free of charge. The Fingerprint Clearance (ACT 114) is approximately \$25.00. Please note: The Wayne County Sheriff's Department is now providing fingerprinting services- you can register at <https://www.identogo.com/locations/pennsylvania> or walk-in only on Fridays, from 8:30 to 11:20 a.m. and 12:20 to 4:10 p.m.**

Once your clearances are approved, you will be contacted by Bernice Fiorella, Mindy Maros or a member of our Wildcat Great Days Team to be put on the schedule in one of our buildings.

Our goal in everything we do in the Western Wayne Community is to raise generations of healthy, happy and successful students who know they are seen, valued and important.
